Expenditures

- There were no expenditures this month.

- There was no official practice in December.
- The January practice will be held on Saturday, January 17, 1-4 pm on Tasia's house.

Other Activities

- Valentin has been busy at work creating charter blanks that can be used for whatever baronial purposes are needed. Sibiliala's started adding these to the OneDrive but there are a few not in there yet: Scroll Charter Blanks
- For 2026, Sibiliala is contemplating some Scribal "Maker" classes that focus more on creating mordants, paints, and other materials. (This may be a case where we all learn together.) This would be in addition to the regular Scribal practices which will continue as they have been.
 - o Bella provided a potential lead on an alternate meeting space at the Tacoma Public Library. Sibiliala has reached out to the contact at the Remakery in hopes of meeting with them after the holidays but has not heard back yet.
 - o Noting that due to their calendar, it isn't anticipated that any gathering would be able to happen before February or March depending on when they get back to us, if the officers agree, and if an agreement can be reached about using the space. This is fact-finding only at this point to be able to propose something to the barony and scriptorium.
- Sibiliala is working on a proposal for a scribal outreach kit (the illumination petting zoo) to be used at demos, schools, and public events. This is based on the "history box"/"traveling trunk" frameworks that are used by local museums like the History

Museum, TAM, the Burke, etc. It will have activities and hands-on items with instructions so that anyone can borrow the box, Scribe or not, and be able to use it for demos. The goal is to have something ready by Rose Tourney/summer.

- o The initial framework will be provided to the baronial officers for review/comment early next year, as well as a plan for development and feedback from the broader barony/scribal community.

- o Sibia will also be soliciting ideas and contributions from others – the intention of this is to create a living framework that can be changed and reworked as new ideas come forward and we learn what works and what doesn't.

YAC: I have an online meeting with my Superiors to work on the Handbook with Q&A. I hope someone will take the YAC position and make good use of the \$1800 I had placed from post pandemic Bake sale proceeds in the fund for ALL forms of Youth combat. Not just Heavy fighting.
