Herald's Point also ran The Game of Hearts (A scavenger Hunt for paper hearts inspired by the heraldry of Catterina Fontana) There were two prizes: a heart picture frame and a heart shaped wooden sign with a poem on it. Both were painted, and word-smithed by Catterina Fontana and both were won by a youth (I have his name written down and will update the Facebook post and send out that revision email with that as soon as I have access to that notebook)
